Footnotes

FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL lunged and then bobbed at the break, stalked the pace from outside NOBLE BANDIT, responded when set down in the drive and wore that one down to edge clear in the closing sixteenth. NOBLE BANDIT moved to front early and made all the pace from along the inside then could not handle the winner through the closing sixteenth. VICTORY TOUCH dropped back off the early pace racing three to four wide, rallied through the far turn then swung six wide into the lane and rallied to gain position while not a threat to the top pair. FOUNDATION ROOM (IRE) saved ground in reach of the pace but failed to mount a solid bid. RED HEADED WOMAN broke off stride to come away awkwardly, recovered quickly to follow the pace from three wide, angled five wide into the lane but had no late run. LIGHT SWEET CRUDE reared then became entangled with her head over into the neighboring stall at the break to come away some thirty lengths behind the field then completed the course in an even manner.
