Footnotes

CAPRINA set all the pace from the inside and drove clear in the final stages. MISS HICKORY pressed the pace, raced three wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. QUEEN ME stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and had no late winning bid. FAST CITY GIRL stalked the pace, raced four wide at the eighth pole and was no late threat. DIANNA'S D. D. raced four wide and never was a factor. KAFLEEN raced a bit wide around the first turn, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never menaced. REAL BATTLEAXE raced three wide and never threatened. PIANO GIRL dwelt at the start, was rushed from the inside and tired in the drive.
