A STARTER ALLOWANCE FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, THREE AND FOUR YEAR OLDS, WHICH HAVE BROKEN THEIR MAIDENS FOR \$10,000 OR LESS AND HAVE NOT BEEN CLAIMED SINCE FEB. 24, 2011 AND STARTED A MINIMUM OF ONE TIME AT FONNER PARK OR LINCOLN RACE COURSE IN 2011. Horses must be eligible at time of entry. With \$12,500 of which 60% to the Winner, 20% to 2nd, 12% to 3rd, 5% to 4th and 3% to 5th. Additionally, all remaining finishers to receive \$300 each.

Weights, 3-year-olds 117 lbs., 4-year-olds 122 lbs. First Preference to horses that have raced only in Nebraska since Feb. 24, 2011.

Second Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings in 2011. **Claiming Price:** \$10,000 - \$0

JUST HANK alternated on the pace from inside PLANTOBEREADY through the opening half mile, edged clear into the lane then needed his best to hold safe late as that rival rallied back. PLANTOBEREADY alternated on the pace from outside the winner, came out through the lane but rallied back late and was slowly reeling in the winner. ALWAYS ON A QUEST tracked the leaders racing three to four wide, challenged near the far turn then could not sustain the run. ABEL WINAPRIZE moved up three and four wide but could not threaten the top ones. MOON ON OVER saved ground and improved position through the lane while not a threat. AFRIENDFORLUCY stalked the pace from along the inside and tired. CHATHAM BARS failed to offer a bid racing four wide. ARCHULETA stalked the pace in good position from three wide and tired.
