A STARTER ALLOWANCE FOR COLTS & GELDINGS, THREE AND FOUR YEAR OLDS, WHICH HAVE BROKEN THEIR MAIDEN FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$10,000 OR LESS AND HAVE NOT BEEN CLAIMED SINCE FEBRUARY 18, 2010 AND STARTED A MINIMUM OF 1 TIME AT FONNER PARK OR LINCOLN RACE COURSE IN 2010. Horses must be eligible at time of entry. With \$12,500 of which 60% to the Winner, 20% to Second, 12% to Third, 5% to Fourth and 3% to Fifth. Additionally, all remaining finishers to receive \$300 each. Footnotes

WATCH THE GAP tracked the pace from outside CUVEE STAR to late backstretch, challenged through the far turn to edge clear in midstretch then held safe under steady handling. MISSION ENVISIONED settled back off the pace racing three and four wide, moved out to launch his rally five wide into the lane and closed with good energy to move well clear for the place while unable to reach the winner. SODA POP SAM stalked the pace in good position racing two or three wide then regained position through the lane but lacked a solid closing response. MOPED BOB was just off the leaders while saving ground and weakened some nearing the lane. NUMBER ONE EDITION dropped back off the pace racing outside early, moved up five wide into the lane but could not threaten. CUVEE STAR broke hard into the side of the gate and came away sideways then quickly recovered to move to the front and gain the inside in the opening furlong, contested the pace to upper stretch and came up empty. BENJAMIN E. lunged at the break then failed to threaten racing four wide. CODY BOY followed the pace in good position while three or four wide and weakened. RUN FOUR DADDY saved ground and was always back.
