Footnotes

ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE move the front from along the inside through the first turn, continued on the pace then settled back a bit nearing the stretch but responded through the lane to rally back and edged clear late. GAMBLERS RULE saved ground while towards the back and unhurried early, moved out in late backstretch to rally three and four wide in the far turn then closed through the lane but could not reach the winner. URA STAR stalked the pace in good position from four wide to bid into the lane then could not sustain the run. SENORITA CONCHITA moved up outside the leaders to vie four wide leaving the first turn, got a head in front and contested the lead to upper stretch then weakened a bit late. PHOEBE'S TUNE trailed early while saving ground, moved out through the far turn then was packed about nine wide into the lane as the field fanned out and moved up while not a threat. MOM'S INTUITION raced outside while midpack early, angled out nearing the lane then fanned herself eight wide into the stretch. VASATI moved up between rivals in the first turn to contend, was in tight quarter passing under the wire for the first time in the lead group, angled in through the second turn and remained in reach to the far

turn then weakened. STREAKIN BEAUTY stalked the pace racing three to four wide, moved up outside through the far turn then angled seven wide into the stretch and lost ground. MOOD WINNER saved ground through the second turn, angled out heading up the backstretch to move three to five wide and weakened. ME A TEAZA was four wide in the first turn, angled in through the second turn to save ground the remainder and had no bid.
