BUDDY GEORGE was content to drop well back off the early pace racing about three wide, swung out through traffic and rallied through the far turn, angled five wide into the lane and finished with a good late run to quickly collar the leaders and move clear under steady handling. ANOTHER BUMPER stalked the pace from along the inside early, moved out from the rail heading up the backstretch to bid into the far turn, moved clear into the lane then had little left in the closing sixteenth while saving position. KALEBS ABLUMIN moved to a clear lead in the first turn from outside rivals to gain the three path, continued on the lead to late backstretch, continued evenly in the lane and was outfinished for position late. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR saved ground while moving up through the far turn, continued from between rivals in deep stretch and just missed the show. NIC A JACK steadied from between rivals while showing speed in the first turn, settled back to stalk the pace from four wide, made a bid into the far turn and weakened in the lane. INCREDIBLE AFFAIR moved up inside rivals heading up the backstretch with his bid then lacked room and was forced to angle out and weakened from four wide into the lane. THEE HEMI was with the early pace racing three to four wide and tired. DEVILS WAY trailed throughout.
