NOMATTERWHERE stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide early, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to get up in his final strides under all out pressure. EXTRA COIN set all the pace along the inside and finished gamely to just miss. BODACIOUS BUDDA was allowed to settle early, saved ground and made a good late bid. GREAT BLIND DATE stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no late winning bid. OUR MISS PHOEBE was allowed to settle early, raced three deep and never was a factor. GONE RIO dropped back early, raced three deep down the backstretch, moved up five wide in the lane and never was a serious threat. BRAHMS SONG was slow early and never threatened. TALLAHAXIE HILL was hustled along from the outside and tired. ASTRAEA showed little. STEP IT UP STEPH failed to sustain a bid.
