

**HORSEMEN'S PARK - July 25, 2010 - Race 5**

STAKES Omaha S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

AN ALLOWANCE STAKE FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee with \$50 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start. With \$50,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the Winner, 20% to Second, 12% to Third, 5% to Fourth and 3% to Fifth. Additionally, all remaining finishers to receive \$500 each. Weights, 3 year olds 116 lbs., Older 122 lbs. Nonwinners of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs., Of \$15,000 at a mile or over in 2010 4 lbs., Of \$15,000 in 2010 6 lbs., Of \$10,000 in 2010 8 lbs. Maiden and Claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Horses that have started for a claiming price of \$7,500 or less in 2010 to receive least preference unless they have won for a claiming price of \$7,500 or more since then. Total earnings in 2010 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights.

**Footnotes**

TENTH POWER showed speed from the inside going to the first turn to set a contested pace, shook off the challenge of KATE'S MAIN MAN going to the far turn then shook another bid while angling out into the lane and held well to keep THE NUTZ safe in the drive. THE NUTZ settled along the inside through the first turn, remained in good position to rally to the winner in the far turn, awaited room and lost position nearing the lane then rallied back late but could not run that one down. NOMOREWINEFOREDDIE moved up between rivals leaving the first turn to press the pace from three wide, continued from outside the winner the remainder and held well in the lane while outfinished for position late. KATE'S MAIN MAN was caught five and six wide in the turns to give ground, rallied to challenge heading up the backstretch and reach near even terms with the winner into the far turn then could not sustain the move. NITA RIDGE stalked the pace from three wide while always in reach but failed to mount a closing response. SANTAMONICACANYON moved up four wide while not a threat. FIRST CLASS BRASS was five wide early in the first turn, angled in through that bend to save ground but failed to mount a bid. FROM THE ASHES showed early speed from three wide to prompt the pace, settled back in the second turn then re-rallied to challenge going to the far turn, steadied from tight quarters early in that bend and tired. STAR POWER stalked the pace from outside, moved with KATE'S MAIN MAN to challenge into the far turn and tired.
