MYSTERIOUS SOUL unhurried early while settling mid pack two from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn, tipped five wide into the lane and took command in mid stretch and drew clear. STONERIDGE ROCKET away alertly and stalked the early pace while racing three wide, loomed a threat approaching the final turn from the outside, held a narrow lead into the stretch but was no match for the winner while proving clearly second best. TIMBERON drifted wide entering the first turn, carrying a rival wide with him, continued on down the backstretch from the outside, pressed the pace on the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. EL CAPONE showed no early speed while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and through the stretch but was forced to steady in deep stretch when in tight quarters. ETESIAN dueled for the lead one from the rail into the backstretch, battled for the lead from between rivals on the stretch turn but weakened in the stretch drive. MACHO QUITO vied for the early lead three wide into the first turn, held a narrow lead from along the rail down the backside, battled into the stretch before fading late. CHAPEL BOY was carried wide entering the first turn by TIMBERON, raced mid pack down the backside but lacked the needed closing response. SHINGEN BOLT was off a step slow, raced wide throughout and showed little. MR. PRINCIPE trailed throughout and was never a factor.
