Footnotes

JOEY'S JEWEL away alertly, vied two wide for the lead down the backstretch,took command at quarter pole,and drew clear down the lane. FUN AGAIN raced five wide going into the first turn, continued on in the five path, circled up on the outside around the turn and finished willingly. WIN FOR SUSAN was away alertly, stalked the leaders from along the rail, but lacked the needed response. FLAMES ABLAZIN was checked between horses near the wire the first time, stalked the pacesetters one off the rail down the backstretch, and was unable to close ground in the stretch. NASCOPIE was allowed to settle off the pace early, saved ground throughout, but was unable to menace. STRAWBERRY ISLAND trailed the field much of the way and was never a factor. SOUP NOTZEE away alertly, set pace at the rail, but was through after a half mile. Following the running of the race there were two claims of foul, one by the rider of FLAMES ABLAZIN against the rider of JOEY'S JEWEL for interference going to the first turn and by the trainer of FLAMES ABLAZIN against the riders of both WIN FOR SUSAN and JOEY'S JEWEL for alleged interference going to the first turn. After review both claims of foul were disallowed.
