ROCKIN CHEROKEE angled in to save ground into the first turn, held a stalking position into the backstretch while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, took command soon after entering the stretch and pulled clear. YES HE'S TROUBLE allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground along the inside, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed with a rush to be clearly second best. WAILIN' JACK was squeezed soon after the start, trailed the field into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed willingly seven wide in the lane. CANUCKS ROAR pressed the pace four wide into the first turn, continued to battled through the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. TIMELESS STORM away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail, battled gamely into the stretch before fading. DEPUTY'S COMMAND unhurried early while lagging well back, rallied one from the rail through the final turn and closed four wide through the stretch. JOINT CHOICE broke sharply and dueled from between rivals for the lead entering the first turn, forced the issue through the final turn before tiring in the stretch drive. MR JIGSAW allowed to settle well off the early leaders racing one from the rail, but failed to menace. END away well and pressed the early pace three wide into the first turn, continued from between rival in the run to the final turn before weakening.
