MAD ABOUT FUZZ broke sharply and raced to the lead entering the first turn while one from the rail, controlled the pace throughout and was able to hold the closers at bay in the late stages. TEASE THE TIGER away well and stalked the early pacesetter while racing one from the rail, advanced to loom a brief threat approaching the final turn, was unable to match strides with the winner over the final furlong, but was clearly second best. ABERFELDIE away alertly and stalked the pacesetter from along the rail, rallied along the inside approaching the final turn, but needed more in the stretch drive. SMARTY FAWCETT allowed to settle in the early going racing one from the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed willingly in the lane. MUCHO VERDE chased four wide into the backstretch while racing mid pack, rallied four wide into the final turn, but was unable to improve his position in an even effort. LONG GONE BALDRY showed no speed early while lagging towards the rear of the field, saved ground throughout, but failed to menace. HENRY WEST was squeezed at the start and dropped back to trail early, and was never a factor. PAPA'S FLYN ANGEL raced mid pack two from the rail down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
