Footnotes

UNQUIET broke sharply and rushed to the lead entering the first turn one from the rail, opened his lead up on the final turn and increased that advantage through the stretch. THE GOV allowed to settle in the early stages while racing two from the rail, angled in entering the final turn to commence his rally, tipped three wide into the stretch, and proved clearly second best. KINGOFTHEROCKIES away alertly and chased the pacesetter one from the rail down the backstretch, was unable to match strides with that rival over the final furlong, but battled gamely throughout. LUCKY MOLY MINER stalked the early leader while saving ground at the rail, faded slightly in the stretch drive in a solid effort. SIR HAYDEN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, never threatened as he was only able to pass tired rivals in the stretch drive. SWEET GILDED TIME angled in to track the leader one from the rail entering the first turn, advanced three wide on the run down the backside, loomed a threat approaching the final turn, but hung over the final furlong. VENI VIDI VICI away well and chased the pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, advanced four wide mid way down the backstretch, but faded over the final furlong.
