Footnotes

TAI SHAN raced mid pack, saving ground throughout, slipped through along the rail mid way through the final turn, opened a clear lead, and was all out for the victory. ROMANCIN TRAVELLER angled in to save ground going into the first turn, tipped three wide turning for home, bumped with PEACH BLOSSOM entering the stretch, and closed with a rush. P S FORGET ME NOT unhurried early, closed ground along the inside on the final turn, and closed strongly along the rail in the drive. INVINCIBLE EAGLE showed little early, began to rallied on the last turn, and closed willingly. VYING FOR VICTORY away alertly, saved ground while dueling for the lead, but faded in the stretch. ARRAIGNMENT showed good early speed to challenge for the lead between horses, raced in the two path and tired the final furlong. BLAME THE BUBBLY unhurried early, raced mid pack, and was unable to mack an impact. PATZCUARO raced to the outside, and was never a factor. PEACH BLOSSOM was sent four wide into the first turn, raced on the outside, was bumped turning for home, and faded. NONE OF THAT broke sharply, raced four wide early and stopped. Following the running of the race, the stewards conducted an enquiry into alleged interference entering the stretch. After reviewing the film, the stewards disqualified ROMANCIN TRAVELLER from second to ninth for causing interference to PEACH BLOSSOM at the head of the stretch.
