Footnotes

RANDOM HIGHS unhurried early while settling in towards the back of the field racing three wide into the first turn, advanced two from the rail down the backstretch and loomed a threat entering the final turn, battled from the outside of VICTORY WITH CLASS through the final turn, before putting away that rival and drawing clear in the stretch. VICTORY WITH CLASS broke sharply and stalked the dueling pacesetters while racing one from the rail, pressed the pace into the final turn, was unable to match strides with the winner in the stretch drive but was clearly second best. SKOPA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and improved her position through the final furlong without ever threatening the top pair. DECARZIA stalked the early leaders from along the rail down the backstretch and into the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response. DE VILBISS away well and rushed up to duel for the lead entering the first turn, battled to the outside of INCLUDE THE GRAND to the final turn before weakening. INCLUDE THE GRAND away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled for the lead down the backstretch before tiring over the final furlong. LOST PROPHET hopped at the start, rushed up one from the rail entering the first turn, but faded approaching the final turn. Following the running of the race the stewards conducted an inquiry into the start of the race. After review they deemed that all horses received a fair start.
