BEAUTIFUL BREEZE was away alertly, chased the pacesetter while racing along the rail, collared POP entering the stretch and drew clear in the lane. POP broke sharply, held a clear advantage into the first turn, raced just off the rail down the backstretch, couldn't hold off the winner who moved past her along the rail entering the stretch. REMARKABLY FREE stalked the pace while racing in the two path, remained in contention throughout, but was unable to challenge the top pair. TICK ME OFF settled mid pack, raced just off the rail the entire journey, and never menaced. LAND OF SILVER unhurried early, saved ground at the rail, but was never a factor. STRUT MY STUFF through her head at the start to get away poorly, trailed throughout, and was being eased in the stretch.
