Footnotes

A LASTING PEACE away alertly, set pace from along the rail, opened up clear lead into the stretch, and drew off. LUCK OF THE DEVIL broke sharply, vied for the lead on the outside of A LASTING PEACE down the backstretch, was no match for that foe in the final furlong, but battled gamely to hold the place. MOBIL SUPREME chased the pacesetters from between horses down the backstretch while racing in the three path, continued on in the same path around the final turn and was unable to make up any ground. SMART CALL showed no speed early while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and managed to improve his position in the lane. HEARTBREAK YOGI allowed to settle early, rallied between rivals on the final turn but never menaced. ENERGY INDEPENDENT was sent four wide into the first turn, continued on towards the outside for a half mile, and tired. SOULSHINE BREW raced mid pack while saving ground, and faded in the stretch drive.
