ANGEL CAME DOWN pressed the pace from the outside. gained the lead on the backstretch, prevailed driving under left handed pressure. OLYMPIC DAWN well placed, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied and weakened. DANCER'S HALO never far back, steadily advanced from off the rail, put in a mild rally to the finish well. BIG DEAL LUCILLE unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, was always outrun. RED'S MISS in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from three wide, gained a minor share. WINNING WAVES trailed for the first half mile, showed little and only passed tiring rivals. KATIE'SSECRETTWIST never far back, stalked the pace from off the rail, was through after a half. HOW IZ IT SARAH gained command from the inside, set a pressured pace, gave way on the backstretch. CONTESSA KAT away alertly and allowed to settle, was through early and gave way.
