Footnotes

JACKMAN ROAD tracked the early leaders three wide entering the backstretch, pressed the pace three wide approaching the final turn, took command soon after entering the turn, and held the closers safely at bay in deep stretch. OTTOMAN tracked the early pace one from the rail into the backside, rallied two wide on the final turn, and finished gamely three wide in the lane to prove clearly second best. SECOND ECLIPSE settled off the early pace racing one from the rail in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn and improved his position while closing four wide in the late going. ASPARKINTHEDARK away alertly and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, battled from the inside of JACKMAN ROAD approaching the final turn, but weakened slightly in the stretch drive. MICHAEL'S GLORY broke sharply, but was forced to steady briefly in the early stages when in tight quarters, stalked the pacesetters three wide down the backside, but was outfinished after looming a danger nearing the final turn. I WANT SECONDS away well and vied for the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, eased off the leaders in the run to the final turn, and was through before reaching the turn. SACRED CAUSE settled off the early pace while saving ground along the inside, rallied along the rail on the final turn, but failed to menace. BOOTS GRAY lagged towards the back of the pack in the run through the first turn, and was never a factor. WANDERING MIRACLE trailed throughout.
