Footnotes

SWONGS away well and pressed the pace entering the first turn from the outside of DICTATORSHIP, battled with that rival into the stretch and prevailed in the final strides while well out from the rail. DICTATORSHIP away alertly and rushed to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled throughout from along the inside of SWONGS and just failed to last in the late going. LATE NITE LARRY raced mid pack while just out from the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and finished evenly. MOBIL SUPREME unhurried early while settling well off the early leaders racing three wide down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn, and advanced along the inside entering the stretch to improve his position. UNDER THE HOOD broke sharply and stalked the dueling pacesetters while racing one from the rail down the backside, but faded gradually over the final furlong. INVINCIBLE EAGLE raced one from the rail into the backstretch, was devoid of early speed and was never able to menace. CASH LAND trailed throughout and was never a factor.
