Footnotes

CASTINETTE DANCER stalked the early pacesetters while saving ground at the rail into the backstretch, rallied one from the rail on the final turn,tipped four wide into the stretch and was up in the closing strides. NOTORIOUSLY dueled for the lead entering the first turn while racing one from the rail, pressed the pace down the backside, took command approaching the final turn, opened a clear lead on the final turn and was just unable to hold off CASTINETTE DANCER in the final strides. ORCHID'S SILVER chased three wide into the first turn, pressed the pace two from the rail nearing the final turn, and finished well in a solid effort. WANDO WOMAN unhurried early while lagging towards the rear of the field, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and closed with interest. DASHING DAISY chased four wide into the first turn, held a striking position from the four path down the backside but lacked the needed closing response. OVERVALUED broke sharply and vied for the lead entering the first turn from the inside of NOTORIOUSLY, battled with that rival down the backstretch but faded over the final furlong. DEAREST PRINCESS unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a serious factor.
