Footnotes

RIBOLETTO vied for the early lead while racing along the inside, opened a clear lead down the backstretch and widened his advantage in the lane while being ridden out. DEE'S VICTOR raced four wide into the first turn, continued along on the far outside, rallied outside of rivals on the final turn, and was easily second best, while never threatening the winner. ROSES FOR BEN no speed early, lagged behind the field, closed the final furlong to improve his position. MR. VICTORIOUS dueled two wide for the early lead, couldn't match strides with RIBOLETTO down the backstretch, and faded a bit late. JUMP TO IT saved ground early, chased the leaders while racing just off the rail, and tired in the lane. DREAM IN THE DARK broke sharply, allowed to settle towards the rear while racing wide, was through early. STREET PATROL saved ground early, to no avail.
