CASTINETTE DANCER broke sharply, was taken off the pacesetters entering the first turn, tipped three off the rail mid way around the first turn,began to inch closer half way down the backstretch,rallied three wide on the final turn,and closed strongly in the final sixteenth to get up in time. OVERVALUED away alertly, held a clear advantage until mid stretch but was unable to hold off a fast closing CASTINETTE DANCER. BELLE EVANGELINE chased the pacesetter down the backstretch, was unable to keep up, but held well for the show. VICTORY WITH CLASS stalked the pace while saving ground down the backstretch,mounted a mild bid on the final turn, but was unable to threaten. PIGTAILS no speed early, raced to the outside down the backstretch, improved her position while never posing a threat. INVESTSOURCE lagged behind early, and gained slightly late. NUJ NUJ WINK WINK chased the speed while saving ground, but had little to offer in the final furlong and weakened.
