REGAL RED broke sharply, pressed the early pace from the outside, gained the lead on the backstretch, drew off around the second turn and was ridden out as much the best. CRYSTAL GALA in the middle of the pack, made a middle move from between horses, finished well as second best but was no match for the winner. SOCORRO COUNTY unhurried early, rallied from three wide on the second turn, finished well. BULLSEYE BESS away alertly and well placed, stalked the leaders from the two path, weakened in the stretch. BAMBOO ORIENT broke sharply, chased the leaders for three quarters, tired in the stretch. BASKET OF DREAMS slow early, showed little and failed to menace. SHE'S A BOMBSHELL trailed early, showed little and never got involved. SILENT BET broke sharply, gained command from the inside, set the early pace, tired and dropped back.
