SENSE OF HUMOR broke sharply, assumed command and drew clear, led throughout, drifted out entering the stretch, prevailed driving. STREAKIN' MOHICAN hustled along, chased and pressed the pace, rallied on the inside, held the place. VICTOR'S MAGIC allowed to settle, gaining from three wide, rallied on the two path, finished well. DYNA STROLL broke sharply, stalked the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch. LADNER LAD unhurried early, gaining, four wide on the backstretch, had no rally. COUNTRY KID slow early, gaining from off the rail, weakened. MACONDO in the middle of the pack, was through early and dropped back. HAMPTON WICK hustled along, tracked the leaders from three wide, was through after the half.
