DOUBLE MINOR away well and raced to a narrow advantage from along the inside entering the first turn, turned back a challenge from DA CORSA approaching the final turn, opened a clear advantage entering the turn and widened in the drive. MY DUBAI settled off the early pace racing three wide into the first turn, continued on four wide down the backstretch, angled in to save ground approaching the final turn to commence a two wide rally, and closed willingly in the drive. DA CORSA away alertly and stalked the leader into the backside racing two from the rail, loomed a danger as he advanced three wide nearing the final turn, but was unfinished over the final furlong. BALOCH OR broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied four wide entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response in the late stages. BEDROOM BULLY settled off the early pace while racing one off the rail through the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but was unable to improve his position in an even effort. A DEVIL'S CAUSE stalked the pace from along the inside into the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. BITE YOUR TONGUE unhurried early, and raced three and four wide while trailing throughout.
