Footnotes

ARRAIGNMENT broke sharply, dueled for the lead from along the rail,and held VYING FOR VICTORY at bay. VYING FOR VICTORY away alertly, vied for the lead while racing one off the rail,drifted into the three path in the stretch, but was unable to make up ground late. BLAME THE BUBBLY carried five wide entering the first turn,trailed down the backstretch,made a mild bid entering the final turn, and closed three wide in the lane to get up for a share. FOREVERINTIME unhurried early, while saving ground at the rail,rallied on the final turn,but lost ground in the stretch. RIO NOVO chased the pacesetters three wide through the first half mile, and tired in the final furlong. MAUPASSANT drifted entering the first turn carrying WANDERABOUTME and BLAME THE BUBBLY extremely wide, raced three wide down the backstretch and was through early. WANDERABOUTME was carried five wide entering the first turn,rallied between rivals mid way down the backstretch, broke down nearing the three eight's pole.
