**Footnotes**

PEACE BEAR away well and tracked the dueling pacesetters from along the rail, slipped through along the inside to challenge for the lead mid way down the backstretch, took command into the final turn and drew clear. NOW ACT broke sharply and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, pressed the pace three wide down the backside, was no match for the winner over the final furlong but battled through the stretch to hold the place. DEE'S VICTOR stalked the leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied four wide on the final turn and finished well in a solid effort. MATCHABULL away alertly and rushed up to vie for the lead entering the first turn from along the rail, dueled between rivals down the backstretch, dropped back on the final turn, but showed some late interest in deep stretch. KANONKULE unhurried early while lagging towards the rear, saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed willingly in the stretch. KALOOKAN BOSS showed no early speed while dropping back, raced three wide down the backside, showed some late interest while never a serious threat. SWISS ARROGANT was squeezed soon after the start to get away slowly, raced mid pack while saving ground down the backside but faded over the final furlong. TOO MUCH DIRT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor. HORNBLOWER raced three wide into the backstretch, but was through early.
