TAYLOR SAID away alertly and vied for the lead in the run to the first turn, steadied when in tight at the rail entering the first turn, assumed a tracking position behind the dueling leaders through the backstretch racing one from the rail, quickly rushed four wide to take command entering the final turn and drew clear through the final furlong. ST LIAMS HALO dueled for the lead three wide into the first turn, battled down the backstretch from the outside of NORTHERN CAUSEWAY to the final turn, could not match strides when collared by TAYLOR SAID entering the final turn, but finished well to prove clearly second best. SENOR ROJO showed no early speed while getting a ground saving trip at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch. JUMP UP AND KISSME away well and tracked the pacesetters into the backstretch racing three wide, advanced six wide approaching the final turn and finished evenly in a game effort. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY vied for the lead into the first turn racing one from the rail, battled three wide down the backstretch, but faded slightly over the final furlong. QUINTONS DESTINY unhurried early while devoid of early speed, trailed into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn, and closed deep on the track through the stretch showing some late interest. CREW LEADER raced four wide into the backstretch, posted a mild bid over the final stages but never seriously menaced. THREE WOOD raced three wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn but was unable to make an impact. CITY TROOPER showed no early speed while lagging towards the rear, raced one from the rail into the backstretch and failed to menace. DOLLARWAITNONADIME broke sharply and chased the early leaders one from the rail into the backside, advanced five wide from between rivals near the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. SILLY FELLA chased the early pace from along the rail into the backstretch, but was through before reaching the final turn.
