KOKEENO broke sharply, chased the pace setter from off the rail, rallied and gained the lead on the second turn, drew off being ridden out. WALKING SPIRIT well placed, stalked the pace, gaining from off the rail, rallied and was up for the place. HOW IZ IT SARAH assumed command, drew clear and gained the rail, set the pace, gave way. REGAL ROO unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. MINING INTERACTIVE well placed, stalked the pace from the inside, weakened after the half. MISS VIMY RIDGE unhurried early, stalked the pace from three and four wide, failed to menace. BRYMIC'S STARLITE bumped at the start, trailed for the first half mile, showed little. WANNA BE FOXY in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from three wide, was through early.
