MONSTERINTHECLOSET unhurried early, gaining from three wide, rallied from four wide, gained the lead at mid stretch, drew clear driving. GATHER DE JUSTICE away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from three wide, gained the lead on the second turn, gave way. ARRIVEE ARRIVEE hustled along, gaining from three wide, weakened in the stretch. RETURNOTIS broke sharply, gained command and the rail, set a pressured pace, gave way. T DRIVE broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from the inside, weakened after the half. HICKORY slow early, showed little and was not a threat. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from off the rail, failed to menace. AMBRATO trailed for the first half mile and showed little. DO NO EVIL away alertly, pressed the pace from between horses, was through after a half.
