INISH GLORA unhurried early, rallied from three wide on the backstretch, after a long drive gained the lead late in the stretch and won driving. GROOMS DERBY away alertly, pressed the pace from the outside, took over the lead at the upper stretch, gave way late. ALWAYS A DIXIE away alertly and well placed, rallied from four wide down the stretch and finished well. WITHOUTAPPROVAL away alertly and allowed to settle, rallied from three wide through the stretch and also finished well. COW IN SOLANA hustled along three wide around the first turn, steadily advanced, weakened after a half. QUEEN OF MY NIGHTS away alertly, gained command from the inside, set a rapid pressured pace, gave way at the upper stretch. CATAHOULA ROSE was slow early and showed little. MISS BLUE BAYOU away alertly and allowed to settle, was through early and dropped back.
