Footnotes

WESTERN WHO settled off the early leaders racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied two from the rail on the final turn and was up in the closing strides while three wide. FOURTEENFORTY was forced to steady sharply in the early going when in tight between rivals, tracked the leaders three wide into the backstretch, pressed the issue three wide into the final turn, held a narrow advantage in deep stretch but was nipped at the wire. SACRED CAUSE tracked the dueling leaders four wide in the run down the backside, advanced to loom a threat approaching the final turn, rallied four wide on the turn, and closed willingly in the stretch while drifting six wide under left handed urging. SECOND ECLIPSE away well and settled off the early leaders into the backside while racing just out from the rail, awaited room approaching the final turn, rallied three wide on the turn, and closed with late interest four wide in the drive. OTTOMAN vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled for the lead through the final turn and into the stretch but was outfinished in the drive. BARKLEY BAY raced mid pack into the backside while racing two from the rail, rallied four wide on the final turn, and closed five wide through the stretch while altering course slightly in deep stretch. ASPARKINTHEDARK away alertly and tracked the leaders one from the rail in the run down the backstretch, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. BUENO'S LEGACY broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the onset, battled to the final turn before fading. FOXY FUN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor. WANDERING MIRACLE lagged towards the back of the pack throughout, and showed little.
