Footnotes

ICE RULES stalked the early leaders one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied three wide approaching the final turn, took command mid way through the final turn and drew clear in the stretch drive. CHAPEL BOY angled in soon after the start to save ground entering the first turn, traced the leaders three wide into the backside, was forced to steady sharply mid way down the backside while being bumped between rivals,rallied four wide on the final turn, and proved second best. OTTOMAN stumbled at the start to get away slowly, settled well off the early leaders while racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied two from the rail into the final turn and closed four wide in the stretch drive to get up for a share. FRIAR TUCK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped six wide into the stretch and closed willingly in the lane. ETESIAN away well and tracked the early pacesetters four wide into the backstretch, held a striking position to the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response. OSCAR NIGHT away well, and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the backstretch, but faded over the final furlong. WANDERABOUTYOU broke sharply and vied for the early lead from along the rail, but began to tire after pressing the pace for a half mile. WILD DRAGON chased the pace three wide into the backstretch, raced a bit greenly in the run down the backstretch, and weakened in the late stages.
