Footnotes

HORNBLOWER threw his head soon after the start to get away a bit awkwardly, quickly rushed four wide into the first turn to enter contention, chased from the outside down the backside, engaged THE PHENOM entering the final turn, took command into the stretch, swerved in deep stretch and was all out to hold off STOLENOTIS. STOLENOTIS away well, raced two wide into the first turn, rallied three wide on the final turn, closed fastest of all in the stretch and checked nearing the wire. THE PHENOM away alertly, quickly angled towards the rail before the wire the first time, held a clear lead down the backstretch, was collared entering the far turn, and tired in the stretch. TAI SHAN unhurried early, rallied three wide on the final turn and improved his position in the lane. HARTLEY BAY took back when in tight soon after the start, saved ground throughout, but lacked any rally. VERNON CAT broke sharply, chased the pace from along the rail, but tired in the final furlong. CASH LAND showed no speed, and never menaced. PATH TO HOME ducked in as he shied away from THE PHENOM away from the gate, rushed two wide into the first turn to chase the pacesetter, but faded badly in the final furlong. Following the running of the race there were two jockey claims of foul. The rider of HARTLEY BAY against the rider of THE PHENOM for alleged interference in the run away from the gate. And the rider of STOLENOTIS against the rider of HORNBLOWER for alleged interference in deep stretch. After review, both claims of foul were disallowed.
