Footnotes

BRIDGE JUMPER broke sharply and rushed to a clear lead approaching the first turn racing along the inside, held his lead through the turn and was never challenged. PINEAPPLE chased the early pacesetter into the turn racing one from the rail, was unable to make up ground on the winner, but finished well to hold the place. LADY HENRIETTA away well and chased the leader into the turn racing along the inside, tipped four wide into the stretch and finished well. WILLAMETTE advanced from along the rail on the turn, and was closed ground through the stretch one from the rail. PROHIBITING chased four wide into the turn, raced four wide into the stretch but lacked a closing kick. LAZARIA LASS was forced to steady entering the turn when in tight between rivals, rallied along the inside on the turn, but was unable to threaten. POOGIE raced one from the rail on the turn, but lacked the speed to ever menace. BLUEGRASS MAN away alertly, but lacked the early speed to remain in contention and was never a serious factor.
