GOOD BAD N UGLY broke sharply and rushed to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, dueled from along the inside of SWONGS into the final turn, held a narrow advantage into the stretch and was all out to hold off the late closers. TEASE THE TIGER away well and tracked the early pacesetter from along the rail into the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn, slipped through along the rail to challenge for the lead entering the lane, was in tight mid way through the stretch, and just missed in the final strides. SWONGS squeezed slightly at the start, rushed up four wide entering the first turn and challenged for the lead entering the backstretch, dueled three wide into the final turn and battled through the stretch from the outside of GOOD BAD N UGLY in a game effort. MAUDEST DANCER stalked the early leaders racing three wide down the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn and was gaining ground on the leaders in the stretch drive. VYING FOR VICTORY unhurried early while dropping back to trail entering the first turn,raced four wide down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn,and closed willingly in the stretch from the outside. DISTORTED GLAMOUR away alertly and tracked the pace into the backside while racing three wide, but weakened in the late stages. GUNS N GOLD showed no speed, while lagging back, and failed to menace.
