Footnotes

THREE WOOD unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced one from the rail down the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn, took command in deep stretch and inched clear. INHISGLORY broke sharply and stalked the early leaders into the backstretch while racing three wide, rallied two from the rail on the final turn, and closed gamely in the stretch to get up for the place from between rivals. THE GOD OF REIGN away alertly and rushed to the lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, opened a clear lead non the final turn, but was unable to hold off the closers in deep stretch. GANBEI showed no speed while lagging towards the rear of the field, rallied five wide on the final turn, and was gaining ground in the stretch drive. HEAVENLY CHORUS chased the pacesetter four wide into the first turn, pressed the pace to the final turn, but faded over the final furlong. DYNA STROLL tracked the leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, advanced along the inside approaching the final turn, but was forced the steady sharply when in tight entering the final turn, and dropped back. SPAGHETTI MOUSE chased the early leader three wide into the first turn, but was through before reaching the final turn.
