SILVER SIDI away alertly, pressed the pace, rallied, gained command turning for home and prevailed driving. SMUGGLERS COVE stalked pace 3 wide, rallied, lost whip in the upper stretch. FLEET ALBERTA bumped at the start, was hustled along, had to go 4 wide on the 2nd turn and finished well. QUICK ACCESS trailed, put in a mild rally late but was outrun. DUCHESS OF PERTH had a mild rally and only passed tiring rivals. TABEER swerved at the start was gaining before giving way. FORCED OUT away alertly, assumed command, set the pace then tired. ISSUE THE WRIT was well placed but through after a half. DIAMOND ALY was never a factor.
