LASTING SPICE away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied and gained the lead coming out of the second turn, drew clear, driving. SWEET N SOUR broke sharply, assumed command and gained the rail, set the pace, gave way, held the place. DASHING DAISY broke sharply, pressed the pace from the rail, weakened and gave way. RAINBOWSINTHEWOOD trailed for the first three quarters, rallied from three wide and was outrun. EMERALD CITY broke sharply, allowed to settle, showed little and failed to menace. MISS KAY DEE RAINE never far back, stalked the pace from the inside, failed to respond. SEDONA MISS never far back, stalked the pace from three wide, was through after the half.
