Footnotes

GUNS N GOLD raced three wide into the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch, rallied between rivals one from the rail on the final turn, and closed well late to get up in time. LATE NITE LARRY broke sharply, chased the pacesetter while racing one from the rail, took command entering the stretch, and was caught in the final stride. HENRY WEST unhurried early, commenced a four wide bid down the backside, and closed five wide in the lane. VICTORY CLAP stalked the pace racing one from the rail, but lacked the needed response. SIMPLY SAM away alertly, held a clear lead down the backstretch, but tired in the final furlong. LONG GONE BALDRY lacked speed, and was never a factor. NOTEMYTIME ducked out away from the gate, rushed up four wide into the first turn to enter contention, continued on from the outside, and drifted out while fading in the lane.
