MY CHOICE hustled along, chased and pressed the pace from three wide, gained the lead on the second turn, drew clear driving. AGLERON hustled along, gaining from four wide, rallied on the second turn and was second best. OLAXSA trailed early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from five wide and finished well. LORNEFIVEHUNDRED never far back, gaining from four wide, weakened in the stretch. COLLINS BROS. broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, was through after a half. EL FIERO in the middle of the pack, saved ground, failed to menace. GANBEI slow early, showed little and was not a threat. JALEPENO JESS hustled along to be close up, gained a short lead on the backstretch, gave way. VICTORS PRINCE broke sharply, gained command from the inside, set a pressured pace, was through early and dropped back.
