POP ARTIST away alertly, chased the leaders from off the rail, gained the lead from the inside on the backstretch, prevailed driving. SENOR ROJO never far back, gaining from three wide, rallied, closed and was second best. TEST PILOT unhurried early, gaining from three wide, was outrun in the stretch. SLICKSTER broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, weakened after the half. BOUNDLESS CAT broke sharply, gained command from the inside, set an early pressured pace, bore out leaving the first turn, weakened. WILDWOOD SWING trailed early, gaining from three wide, put in a mild bid from five wide, was not a threat. BRENNIVEN in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch. ZIP THE STORM hustled along to be close up, chased the leaders from three wide, was through after a half. LATE NITE LARRY slow early, pulled up leaving the backstretch.
