WILLAMETTE away alertly, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear lead entering the final turn, and was all out to hold off the late closers in game fashion. LOCKET settled well off the early pace entering the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, rallied from just off the rail entering the final turn, and closed determinedly from between rivals in deep stretch to get up for the place. BAMBOO DREAM stalked the dueling leaders into the first turn while racing one out from the rail, commenced a four wide bid entering the final turn, and closed willingly three wide in the drive in a solid effort. KATALIAH stalked the leaders into the backstretch racing along the rail, tipped three wide entering the final turn to rally smartly, and closed four wide in the drive. SUPER DIVINE bobbed in the opening strides, and raced a bit rank when taken in hand, lagged well back in the early running, rallied two wide through the final turn, and closed one from the rail with late interest in the drive. PRETTY RECKLESS away well, and tracked the leaders through the first turn racing one from the rail, rallied smartly three wide entering the final turn, but weakened in the drive. GRAFFITI GRACE hopped at the start to get away slowly, trailed the field in the run down the backstretch, and was never a factor. MISS DICKIE broke sharply, and dueled for the lead two wide entering the first turn, chased the pacesetter to the final turn, before weakening.
