KID KATABATIC away alertly and well placed, rallied from three wide on the backstretch, gained command coming out of the second turn, won driving. DIGLETT trailed for the first half mile, rallied from three wide down the stretch, closed willingly and finished well. KING JEREMY away alertly, gained command from the inside, set a rapid pressured pace, without relief gave way on the second turn. I'M FREE away alertly, pressed the pace of KING JEREMY from the outside, weakened after half and gave way. WORK VISA unhurried early, showed little and was never a factor.
