**Footnotes**

OUR LAST CALL away well and raced to a narrow advantage from along the rail entering the first turn, held the lead into the final turn and increased his advantage slightly through the stretch drive. PAYTON'S BEST broke sharply and pressed the pace into the first turn racing one from the rail, chased the leaders two wide through the final turn and proved clearly second best. LORD CALEZAAR broke inwards in the initial strides, then steadied off heels approaching the first turn, stalked the pace into the backstretch before advancing one from the rail nearing the final turn, and closed two wide in the lane. TALLY STICK away alertly and tracked the early pace three wide into the backstretch, rallied two from the rail into the final turn and closed four wide through the stretch drive. TROUBLES A BREW'N was slow into stride while lagging well back, rallied three wide entering the final turn and closed with interest three wide in the lane. BITE YOUR TONGUE tracked the leaders while saving ground at the rail into the backstretch, but began to weaken nearing the final turn. KAI'S COMMAND was bumped at the start to get away slowly, settled off the early pace racing three wide into the backstretch, posted a mild bid down the backstretch, but was never a serious factor. HES NO CLARK GABLE was rank early while dropping well back of the pack, lost touch with the field entering the first turn and was being eased down the backstretch, and was pulled up mid way through the final turn, and walked off.
