Footnotes

SUNNY SOLORO tracked the pacesetters into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, took command entering the stretch from along the inside of BANK ON A LADY and quickly pulled clear. REVSTER unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced four wide down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn, and was gaining ground in the stretch drive. GRAFFITI GRACE stalked the early pacesetters into the backstretch while racing two from the rail, loomed a danger approaching the final turn, but needed more in the late going. BANK ON A LADY away well and vied for the lead into the first turn from along the rail, held a narrow lead into the final turn, was unable to match strides with SUNNY SOLORO when collared entering the stretch and weakened slightly in the late stages. MAZEL'S SECRET broke sharply and dueled for the lead into the first turn from between rivals, pressed BANK ON A LADY into the final turn, but began to fade over the final furlong, and bobbed slightly in deep stretch. ENGLAND SWINGS settled off the leaders entering the first turn racing three wide, continued on from that path down the backside and failed to seriously menace. ONE AWESOME PROMISE raced one from the rail into the first turn while devoid of early speed, and was never a factor. REVELLING away alertly and pressed the pace three wide into the first turn, dropped into a tracking position entering the backside, but began to tire nearing the final turn.
