STORMIN PROUD PAPA away alertly and rushed to the lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail,turned back a bid from SILLY FELLA entering the final turn, and was able to hold the closers safely at bay through the stretch drive. BEARROCK N ROLL settled off the early leaders into the backstretch racing along the inside, rallied one from the rail from between rival on the final turn and finished well to grab the place. SEMINOLE BRAVE broke sharply and chased the pacesetter into the first turn racing two from the rail, tracked STORMIN PROUD PAPA three wide into the final turn, and closed four wide in a solid effort. QUINTONS DESTINY stalked the early leaders racing two from the rail down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed willingly five wide in the stretch under left handed urging, but needed more. SILLY FELLA away well and tracked the pacesetter from along the rail into the first turn, had to check briefly entering the turn while in tight at the rail, loomed a danger from along the rail entering the final turn, but was unable to match strides with the winner over the final furlong, and faded slightly in deep stretch. FULL POWER AHEAD showed no speed while dropping back to trail, and failed to menace. SILVER CITY SAM unhurried early while lagging towards the rear of the field, and was never a factor.
