**Footnotes**

ALITAX away alertly, dueled two wide for the lead, began to open a clear lead mid way through the final turn, and won driving. CALL ME JEWEL chased three wide into the first turn, stalked the pacesetters while racing out from the rail, split rivals mid way through the final turn to take up the chase, but proved second best. MAGIC THUNDER away well, raced mid pack just off the rail, advanced mid turn from between rivals and closed well along the inside. SONGSROYALDIAMOND unhurried early, began to make up ground soon after entering the backstretch, rallied five wide on the final turn and finished evenly. COSTA MARTA was carried four wide entering the first turn, continued on from the outside down the backstretch and was unable to serious challenge. I AIN'T YUR HONEY trailed the field early, and was only able to pass tiring foes. AMY OH MY chased four wide entering the first turn and down the backside, and weakenedbefore the final turn. DRINKINGONTHEJOB came in and the start and bumped I AIN'T YOUR HONEY, angled in to save ground approaching the first turn, was forced to check off heels when running off on rider entering the first turn, saved ground down the backstretch, but began to fade after a half mile. ARABELLA MISS broke sharply, vied for the lead from along the rail, but stopped.
