Footnotes

NOTIS SAL vied for the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, battled down the backstretch from the inside of PRINCIPE'S HERBIE, took command entering the final turn racing one from the rail and increased his advantage through the stretch. FRIAR TUCK brushed the gate to get away slowly, trailed the field into the backstretch, rallied one from the rail into the final turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and closed willing to prove clearly second best. VIRTUAL TIME broke sharply and stalked the early pacesetters into the backstretch racing three wide, loomed up on the outside entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response through the lane. REGAL HONOR away well and tracked the leaders through the first turn and down the backside while racing along the rail, held a striking position throughout, but was outfinished over the final furlong. FOLLOW MY ORDERS settled off the early pace racing one from the rail, dropped back to trail nearing the final turn, and was only able to pass tiring rivals in the stretch drive. FINALLY PROUD raced three wide into the first turn while devoid of early speed, raced five wide down the backstretch and failed to seriously menace. PRINCIPE'S HERBIE away alertly and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn and down the backside, but began to weaken entering the final turn.
